This is not a rated USEF show. These classes do not count towards USEF/USDF recognized championships. You need not to be a member of USEF, USDF or WDAA to exhibit at this show, however, USEF Dressage and Western Dressage rules will apply. For example, all horses must be ridden in an USEF approved dressage bit (appropriate for the division and level) and a whip is allowed but can be no longer than 47.2" or 120cm. Tests will be the USDF/USEF tests as published by these organizations for the current year. All championships are a combination of your two best rides in the same level. To be eligible for a championship award, you must ride in a minimum of 2 different tests at the same level. Ties will be broken using the highest scoring test in that level.

USDF Intro and USEF Dressage Training Level Tests, and Western Dressage Intro and Basic Tests may be held in a small (20x40 meter) arena. USEF Dressage First Level and higher tests, and Western Dressage Level 1 and higher, will be held in the standard (20x60meter) arena. Schooling in the 20 x 60 dressage ring, will be available after 6PM on the evening before the dressage show day, and before 7:30 AM on the morning of the dressage show.

The committee reserves the right to limit the number of riders.

Entries must be postmarked July 28, 2017; late fees added after this date. Final entries CLOSE August 2, 2017. Ride times will be available, on or around Friday August 4, 2017.
